



Makerere University Joint AIDS Program (MJAP)

Request for expression of interest (OVC, Community Referral & Linkage sub-grants)

MJAP is a company limited by guarantee under Makerere University. MJAP emerged from the Mulago-Mbarara Teaching Hospitals Joint AIDS Program which was established in November 2004 under the then Makerere University Faculty of Medicine with funding from the US President's Emergency Plan For AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and technical assistance from the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). With funding from PEPFAR, MJAP currently supports the provision of comprehensive HIV/AIDS services in Mulago, Kiruddu, Kawempe, Butabika and Makerere University Hospitals, Mbarara Regional Referral Hospital and health centers in Mbarara district.

As part of our community engagement strategy, MJAP seeks to sub-grant eligible Community-Based Organisations (CBOs) / Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) including People Living with HIV Organisations to support our facility-community referral & linkage efforts and Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC) programming in our catchment area in Kampala and Mbarara districts. The CBOs/ CSOs will: conduct referral and linkage of persons living with HIV in the communities to quality HIV prevention, care, and treatment services, offer community follow up of patients, support provision of services for OVC, advocacy, community mobilization, and demand creation efforts.
